# International Conference on E-Learning and Educational Technology (ICEET) 2016 – Writing Principal

The style sheet of this periodical is referred from the 《Publication Manual of the American

Psychological Association<sup>®</sup>, Fifth Edition<sup>®</sup>. The followings are the brief relevant principals of texts, citation, references, tables and figures:

# I. Text

- 1. Please check the correction of grammar and the fluency of sentences in both abstract and manuscript before contribution.
- The title of the text should be numbered in order. (i.e., I. Introduction, II. Methods, III. Results, IV. Discussion and V. Conclusions)
- 3. The title of the text should be ordered in the gradation of I, A, 1, a, (1), (a).
- 4. All of the names should not be translated and use initials only at the first time in the text. (i.e., J. Dewey) and use the last name (i.e., Dewey) afterwards.
- 5. Appendix should be placed after References.
- 6. The limitation for poster presentation is 2 to 4 pages; oral presentation should not exceed 8 pages. Please use Times New Roman font only and refer to the Accepted Manuscript Guidelines for further writing principals.

# II. Citation

- 1. Citation is always consistent with the references.
- 2. For citations of up to five authors, list all author names in the first citation, i.e., Si-Hua Huang, Yuan-Zhen Liu and Wan-Ting Yan (2011). Afterwards, only list the first author's name, i.e., Si-Hua Huang (2011).
- 3. For more than six authors, use the first author's name followed by "et al.", i.e., Robbins et al. (1960); Wu-Dian Wu et al. (1972).
- 4. For citing different works of the same author, please use "," to divided the year of publication, i.e., Yuan-Zhen Liu (2007, 2008)
- 5. Please use "/" to identify the year of original and the translation publication, i.e., (Beck, 1991/2001).

- 6. The page number of the extraction or citation should be stated. If the length of the citation exceeds 40 words, please use them with a new paragraph and make an indent at the beginning.
- 7. Please use Halfwidth Forms punctuation in every citation.
- 8. Refer to 《Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association®, Fifth

Edition》 for further principals.

# III. Reference

- 1. References should be listed alphabetically.
- 2. If it is referred to the USA, please list the initial of the State except big cities such as New York, Chicago, etc.
- 3. If it is referred to the countries beyond the USA, please list the name of city and nation; only list the name of city if it is well-known, i.e., Paris.
- 4. List the name of books and periodical volume number in italics.
- 5. Refer to 《Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association<sup>®</sup>, Fifth

Edition》 for further principals.

#### IV. Table and Figure

- 1. List the title above the table; place sequentially captions and sources under the table.
- 2. List the title above the figure; place sequentially captions and sources under the figure.
- 3. Do not state sources if the table or figure is made on your own.
- 4. Please redo the table or figure if it is too blurred to be recognize after been scanned.
